munity in a timely manner. Mail such as this newsletter is slow, cumbersome and expensive. Providing information via the internet through social media and email is inexpensive and timely, but most of us are now so inundated by email, Facebook, Twitter, etc that we still often miss the NF news and alerts that are being given to us.
