ADULTS WITH NF1 NEEDED FOR A COGNITIVE STUDY!

STUDY AIMS:

Our study aims to investigate cognitive patterns and predictors within middle-aged and older adults diagnosed with NF1.

IMPORTANCE:

To increase awareness and understanding of cognitive processes (thinking and memory) among individuals with NF1 and potential predictors of cognitive processes, including age, NF1-related, social, and psychological factors. This research may help inform future management, care, and interventions related to cognitive struggles among adults with NF1.

1. Have a diagnosis of NF1
2. Be 40 years or older
3. Be able to read and speak English
4. Reside in the United States
