What vision related treatments are you comfortable with?



We are looking for caregivers of youth with NF1 optic pathway gliomas to complete a brief 15-minute survey to discuss perspectives on NF1-OPG care and the factors considered in choosing treatments to address vision loss. We are looking to understand what possible risks families can tolerate and what factors would make them feel comfortable with various treatment options. Findings from this work will inform future vision related treatment development.

- Are actively involved in their NF1 care
